





# **LONGCHAMP** [R-H] - **01 October**

#### Race 1 - QATAR PRIX CHAUDENAY - 3000m OPEN. Purse EUR €200,000.

- 1. **DUKE DE SESSA** Battled on well to win the G3 Paddy Power Stakes over 2414m at Leopardstown (Ireland) last outing. Top claims with untapped potential at this trip.
- 2. **AL QAREEM** Held seventh in the G3 John Pearce Racing Gordon Stakes over 2400m at Goodwood (UK) in July. Capable of better having been narrowly denied in the G3 Bahrain Trophy at Newmarket (July) (UK) prior and should appreciate the step up in distance.
- 3. **FASOL** Proved he was up to competing at Group level when runner-up in the course and distance G3 Prix Gerald de Geoffre last start. Hard to dismiss.
- 4. **SOBER** Runner-up to La Mehana in the 2800m Listed Prix Michel Houyvet at Deauville 47 days ago. Each-way player but needs more if he is to reverse that form.
- 5. **ERMELIE** Held sixth in a Class Two conditions event at Saint-Cloud last-time-out. Hard to envisage her featuring.
- 6. **WHILEUWERESLEEPING** Finished 3.5L back in fifth in the G2 Prix de Malleret Prix Le Bonbon at this venue before winning a Class Two Mont-de-Marsan conditions event. More needed upped in trip and standard.
- 7. **LA MEHANA** Progressive filly who won the Listed Prix Michel Houyvet over 2800m at Deauville in August. Greatly respected with this distance likely to be right up her street.

**Summary**: Irish raider DUKE DE SESSA (1) stuck to her task nicely to win the G3 Paddy Power Stakes narrowly over 2400m at Leopardstown (Ireland) last outing. Top chance under Soumillon with untapped potential over this trip. LA MEHANA (7) had Sober 2.5L back in second when winning the the Listed Prix Michel Houyvet tackling 2800m at Deauville in August. Notable claims with this distance likely to be right up her street. AL QAREEM (2) would hold a chance if replicating his good second in the G3 Bahrain Trophy Stakes at Newmarket (July) (UK) two starts ago. FASOL (3) is next best.

# Race 2 - QATAR ARABIAN TROPHY DES JUMENTS (POULICHES 4 ANS) - 2000m PSA. Purse EUR €150.000.

- 1. AL WAKRAH Won the G3 Prix Nevadour over 1900m by 2L at La Teste last start. Key chance.
- 2. MONDA Finished third behind two of these in the 1900m G3 Prix Nevadour at Le Teste. Each-way chance.
- 3. **SAHAB** Runner-up to Al Wakrah in the G3 Prix Nevadour over 1900m at La Teste. Should strip fitter and no surprise were she to get closer to that rival.
- 4. **SULTANA** Shaped nicely when perhaps in need of the run in the G3 Prix Nevadour last outing. Not dismissed.
- 5. **RISKA LOTOISE** Plenty to find with some of these having finished a held ninth in the G3 Prix Nevadour at La Teste last start. Opposed.
- 6. **LILA STAR** Steps up in grade following a 0.5L conditions success over 2000m at Mont-de-Marsan. Hard to assess.
- 7. **MAJOIE DES FORGES** Finished sixth in the G3 Prix Nevadour over 1900m at La Teste. Interesting jockey booking but likely more is needed.
- 8. **HEELYWA** Second in the G2 Sheikh Mansoor Festival Prix Nefta at Toulouse before an extremely disappointing effort in a conditions event at the same venue. Must bounce back.
- 9. **FLEUR DU SOLEIL** Finished fifth behind Lila Star at Mont-de-Marsan last-time-out and has to work to do on that form.
- 10. **SOLENZANA** Sent off favourite for the G3 Prix Nevadour when shaping nicely in fourth after a break. Strong contender on her G2 Sheikh Mansoor Festival Prix Nefta win in April.
- 11. ARIADNA Finished fourth behind Lila Star at Mont-de-Marsan three weeks ago. Best watched.
- 12. **TAMARI** Produced a fair 5L fourth behind a pair of subsequent winners in the G3 Sheikh Mansoor Festival Coupe du Sud-Ouest des Pur-Sang Arab at La Teste latest. Interesting.

**Summary**: This looks to revolve around the G3 Prix Nevadour that took place over 1900m at La Teste six weeks ago. AL WAKRAH (1) ran out a 2L winner over SAHAB (3) on that occasion and both look to be firmly involved once more but the latter has the services of Mickael Barzalona this time around and could reverse the placings with some solid G1 form in the past. SOLENZANA (10) was sent off favourite for that event when fourth and can be thereabouts with a step forward possible. TAMARI (12) is also respected.

- 1. **JANNAH FLOWER** Keeping on fourth (beaten 1L) behind Sea La Rosa and Love Child in the 2500m G2 Darley Prix de Pomone at Deauville. Step back up to 2800m looks a plus.
- 2. **LOVE CHILD** Good second to Sea La Rosa in the G2 Darley Prix de Pomone before finishing down the field in the G1 Qatar Prix Vermeille 20 days ago. Each-way claims with proven form over the trip.
- 3. **VERRY ELLEEGANT** Top-rated mare who missed out on a run in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Raced from the front when a 1.5L third in the 2400m G2 Qatar Prix Foy and looks a player with the step up in trip likely to pose no issues.
- 4. **SEA LA ROSA** Improving four-year-old who recorded her third win from four starts this year when taking out the G2 Darley Prix de Pomone over 2500m at Deauville. Top chance with further progress possible.
- 5. **CONTROL TOWER** Finished 4L back in fifth in the G2 Darley Prix Kergorlay over 3000m at Deauville last month. Others look to hold slightly stronger claims.
- 6. **QUEEN TREZY** Finished behind Sea The Sky in the course and distance Listed Prix Joubert last-timeout. Bit more required on that form.
- 7. **SEA THE SKY** Lightly-raced filly who seemingly improved for the step up in trip when winning the Listed Prix Joubert narrowly last start. Interesting but will need to continue her progress.
- 8. **EMILY DICKINSON** Finished third behind Sea La Rosa at Goodwood (UK) before a solid effort when fifth (beaten 1L) in the G1 Cazoo St Leger Stakes over 2900m at Doncaster (UK). Hard to ignore on ratings for a top trainer.
- 9. **PEROTAN** Represents top trainer Aidan O'Brien. Could improve for the step up in journey but will need to following a fair fourth in the G3 Paddy Power Stakes at Leopardstown (Ireland) three weeks ago.
- 10. **OTTILIEN** Made all the running to win the Listed Prix Turenne over 2400m at Saint-Cloud after a break. This is much tougher.

**Summary**: SEA LA ROSA (4) recorded her third win from four starts this year when taking out the G2 Darley Prix de Pomone over 2500m at Deauville in snug fashion. Top claims with further progress entirely possible. The Aidan O'Brien pair EMILY DICKINSON (8) and PEROTAN (9) are respected with the former preferred of the duo following a good 1L fifth in the G1 Cazoo St Leger Stakes over 2900m at Doncaster (UK). The latter is interesting upped in trip. VERRY ELLEEGANT (3) comes into this top-rated in the line-up and should be on the premises after finishing a 1.5L third in the 2400m G2 Qatar Prix Foy.

#### Race 4 - QATAR PRIX DE LA PLACE DES VOSGES - 2500m HCP CL1. Purse EUR €70.000.

- 1. **NARCOS** Finished sixth when behind Panjaman (third) in a 2500m Class One conditions event at Saint-Cloud. Not dismissed dropped 1kg back in handicap company.
- 2. **PANJAMAN** Good third in a 2500m Class One conditions event at Saint-Cloud last outing. Player but has stall sixteen to contend with.
- 3. **SWEET VICTORY** Finished fifth behind Panjaman in a Class One Saint-Cloud conditions event last outing. Each-way chance.
- 4. **OLYMPIE** Good third when behind Utamaro in a similar Class One handicap at Chantilly four months ago. Makes plenty of appeal under Soumillon.
- 5. **MONSIEUR XOO** Dropped 1.5kg for finishing down the field over 2250m at this venue latest. Others preferred.
- 6. **GOLDEN CALL** Won four on the bounce before deservedly being given a crack in the Listed Prix Turenne at Saint-Cloud. Interesting back in a handicap with an unbeaten record here.
- 7. REVOLTEE Upped 4kg for winning a 2250m handicap here by 0.5L last outing. That may find her out.
- 8. **HAYZUM** Held fifth in a Class Two conditions event over 2400m at Vichy latest. This looks tougher.
- 9. **LAOS** Makes stable debut having won a Class Four conditions event by 4L at Royan La Palmyre last outing. Steps up significant in grade back in handicap company.
- 10. **MY CHARMING PRINCE** Not disgraced when eighth (beaten 2.5L) in a Class Two handicap over 2250m at this venue last outing. Capable of this mark and worth each-way consideration.
- 11. **WOOT CITY** Finished seventh in a 2400m Class Two handicap at Dieppe ten weeks ago. Won sole start over this trip and dropped 0.5kg. Could sneak a place.
- 12. **LA HAUTE ISLE** Just denied in a 2400m handicap at Divonne last outing but needs more back up in class.
- 13. **GOOD QUESTION** Finished down the field behind some of these over 2250m here last start. May need more than a 1.5kg drop in the weights.
- 14. **CREATIVE** Won a Class One handicap over 1800m at Chantilly off 1kg lower in June but shown nothing since. Risky.
- 15. **UTAMARO** Good second behind a subsequent winner over 2400m in a Class Two handicap at Clairefontaine on penultimate outing. Interesting.
- 16. TCHAKOVIEV Well beaten in a lesser handicap tackling 1950m here sixteen days ago. Opposed.
- 17. **HAUTE VOLEE** Arrives following back-to-back narrow Class Three handicap wins at Deauville AW and this venue. Progressing nicely but needs more.
- 18. **RECOUP** Made a pleasing handicap debut when third over 2200m at this track last outing. Interesting for a top yard.

**Summary**: As expected a competitive handicap. OLYMPIE (4) produced a solid third when behind UTAMARO (15) in a similar Class One handicap at Chantilly four months ago. Key contender with Soumillon a positive booking. The latter mentioned finished a close up fifth over 2250m here a month ago and certainly has the form to be involved. PANJAMAN (2) shaped well when third in a 2500m Class One conditions event at Saint-Cloud last outing. Notable chance. RECOUP (18) is interesting from the foot of the weights with further progress likely while it's hard to rule out GOLDEN CALL (6) back in handicap company.

#### Race 5 - HARAS DE BOUQUETOT - CRITERIUM ARQANA - 1600m CL2. Purse EUR €300.000.

- 1. **SOUZAK** Won a Class Two conditions event by a head over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly latest. Interesting upped in trip.
- 2. **DENMARK** Made a very promising start to his career when winning a 1600m Naas (Ireland) maiden by 3L last month. Leading claims for top connections.
- 3. **GAME ON** Won a 1200m Chantilly maiden at the third attempt but should appreciate the step up in trip. Needs more but of interest.
- 4. PIANO MAN More required than when fourth in a 1400m Saint-Cloud maiden last outing.
- 5. **VENICE** Just denied by Souzak in a 1200m maiden at Deauville second-time-out. May not have the same scope for progression as that rival who has improved plenty since.
- 6. COGNAC Second in a maiden over this trip at Deauville last outing. Place claims at best.
- 7. ANGERS Held seventh in the G3 Prix de Conde over 1800m at Chantilly latest. Could sneak a place.
- 8. HENRY THE LION Won a 1700m maiden at Marseille-Borely at the second time of asking. Not discounted.
- 9. **PAPILIO** 10L sixth in the G1 Moyglare Stud Stakes at The Curragh (Ireland) last outing. Hard to ignore and helps set the standard on ratings. Stable debut.
- 10. **CRACKOVIA** Finished runner-up when beaten 0.75L in the Listed Grosser Preis des Laki's Im Ko-Quartier over this trip at Dusseldorf (Germany). Of interest.
- 11. **MUNCH** Won a 1400m Class Two conditions event at Goodwood (UK) last outing. Interesting and clearly handles cut in the ground.
- 12. **NAMMOS** UK raider who finished second in a 1200m Yarmouth (UK) novice event. Each-way chance upped in trip.
- 13. **MARKSWOMAN** 3.5L second in a Class Two conditions event over this distance at Chantilly last start. One for the placings.
- 14. **FILLE DU ROI** Slightly disappointing she could only finish fourth in a 1400m Saint-Cloud maiden when well fancied last outing. Bit more needed.
- 15. **ADEVA** Second to subsequent winners in maiden company here and at Deauville thus far. Frame chance if progressing upped to 1600m.
- 16. **KIMI ORENDA** Won a 1400m maiden at Vichy in July. Hard to assess but probably requires further progress.
- 17. **DREAM OF DEAUVILLE** Made all the running when winning a 1800m maiden at Dieppe on her second outing. Proven over further at least.

**Summary**: An interesting and extremely valuable sales race for the two-year-olds. The presence of Aidan O'Brien's DENMARK (2) catches the eye and given he was very impressive when winning at Naas (Ireland) over this trip on debut he looks the one to side with. MUNCH (11) handled soft ground when winning a Goodwood (UK) conditions event last outing and is one of the more interesting challengers. SOUZAK (1) won a Class Two conditions race by a head over 1350m at Lyon-Parilly latest. Claims with more to come upped in trip. PAPILIO (9) finished 10L sixth in the G1 Moyglare Stud Stakes at The Curragh (Ireland) and must be respected on ratings.

- 1. **GOYA SENORA** Battled on strongly to win the 3000m G2 Darley Prix Kergorlay at Deauville last outing. Progressing nicely and could take another step forward up to 4000m.
- 2. ALMACADO GREE Won a Vichy 3000m handicap last outing but looks well out of his depth here.
- 3. **QUICKTHORN** Completed a hat-trick when winning the 3270m G2 Weatherbys Hamilton Lonsdale Cup Stakes by 14L at York (UK) under an enterprising front-running ride. Key chance.
- 4. **TASHKHAN** Finished fourth behind Quickthorn in the 3270m G2 Weatherbys Hamilton Lonsdale Cup Stakes at York (UK) latest. Will enjoy any cut in the ground. Wears first-time cheekpieces.
- 5. **SAPIENTI** Finished third in a stakes race over 2400m at Praha (Czech Republic) last outing. Looks up against it.
- 6. **SKAZINO** Finished third behind Goya Senora in the 3000m G2 Darley Prix Kergorlay at Deauville latest. Could place.
- 7. **KYPRIOS** Taken the staying division by storm this season winning completing a hat-trick of Group Ones in the G1 Comer Group International Irish St. Leger over 2800m at The Curragh (Ireland). Proven over this trip at Ascot (UK) and the one they all have to beat.
- 8. **VIVIENNE WELLS** Impossible to recommend having won a 2400m Hannover (Germany) handicap last start.
- 9. **JOIE DE SOIR** Denied a head by Goya Senora in the 3000m G2 Darley Prix Kergorlay at Deauville 41 days ago. Included.
- 10. **PRINCESS ZOE** Plenty to find with Kyprios on her sixth in the G1 Comer Group International Irish St. Leger (Ireland) but should appreciate going back up in trip with any rain welcome.
- 11. **LISMORE** Good 0.5L third in the 3600m G2 Doncaster Cup Stakes (UK) last outing. This is tougher but no forlorn hope for a place in first-time blinkers.
- 12. **LUBIANE** Held eighth in the 2800m Listed Happy Birthday Mami 80 Jahre Alexa Grafin Zu Solms Cup at Baden-Baden (Germany) last outing. Look elsewhere.

**Summary**: It's hard to look past KYPRIOS (7) who has really stamped his authority on the staying division this season. Aidan O'Brien's star completed a hat-trick of Group Ones in the G1 Comer Group International Irish St. Leger over 2800m at The Curragh (Ireland) and is the one they all have to beat with this trip no problem. QUICKTHORN (3) won the G2 Weatherbys Hamilton Lonsdale Cup Stakes by 14L at York (UK) under an enterprising front-running ride. Key chance although unlikely he will be allowed to dominate in such fashion. GOYA SENORA (1) just got the better of JOIE DE SOIR (9) in the 3000m G2 Darley Prix Kergorlay at Deauville and they look the pick of the home contingent. SKAZINO (6) finished third in that event and is also noted.

- 1. **BOTANIK** Progressive four-year-old who record a third straight success when winning the G2 Lucien Barriere Grand Prix de Deauville over 2500m at Deauville. Likely to be up with the pace throughout and must be respected.
- 2. **ADDEYBB** Eight-year-old who's best days are perhaps behind him but he wasn't disgraced when third in a decent looking Listed Gala Stakes at Sandown (UK) in July. Gets his conditions and interesting in first-time cheekpieces.
- 3. **GROCER JACK** Finished runner-up to Anmaat at Haydock (UK) before being just denied in the G3 Winter Hill Stakes over 2000m at Windsor (UK). Player under Ryan Moore.
- 4. **WALLY** Showed a good attitude when winning the 2000m G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron Hong Kong Jockey Club over 2000m at Deauville by a head. Cannot be ignored.
- 5. **PAROL** Won the G3 Grosser Preis Der Wirtschaft over 1800m at Dortmund (Germany) three-and-a-half months ago. This is tougher.
- 6. **ANMAAT** Improving type who smashed Grocer Jack by 4L in the 2100m G3 Rose Of Lancaster Stakes at Haydock (UK) last outing. Top claims.
- 7. **HURRICANE DREAM** Just denied second in the 1600m G2 Brunner Oettingen Rennen at Baden-Baden (Germany) four weeks ago. Each-way chance.
- 8. MISS TAKE Winner of a Class Two handicap over 1850m here last start. Outclassed.
- 9. **WEST WIND BLOWS** Picked up smartly to win the 2000m G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange by 1.75L here four weeks ago. Not ruled out.
- 10. **LASSAUT** Good second in the 2400m G2 Qatar Prix Niel here three weeks ago. Hard to discount back in trip.
- 11. **NOBLE HEIDI** Bolted up by 8.5L in the Listed Baden-Baden Cup (Germany) over 1800m last-time-out. This represents a tougher task.
- 12. **JUNKO** Unexposed three-year-old who finished a solid runner-up in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano when tackling 2000m at Deauville on his fifth start. Could have more to offer.

**Summary**: A fiercely-competitive Group Two where many have chances. ANMAAT (6) had GROCER JACK (3) well behind (4L) when winning the 2100m G3 Rose Of Lancaster Stakes at Haydock (UK) last outing. The former looks to be improving rapidly for Owen Burrows and may be up to the task while the latter can go close having been narrowly beaten in the G3 Winter Hill Stakes over 2000m at Windsor (UK) since. Progressive gelding BOTANIK (1) completed the hat-trick when winning the G2 Lucien Barriere Grand Prix de Deauville at Deauville. Expected to measure up and should be ridden positively. Recent G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron Hong Kong Jockey Club winner WALLY (4) cannot be ruled out while LASSAUT (10) is also of interest.

#### Race 8 - QATAR PRIX DANIEL WILDENSTEIN - 1600m OPEN. Purse EUR €200.000.

- 1. **THE REVENANT** High-class seven-year-old and the race could have panned out better when beaten 6.25L into third in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp here. Genuine hope on ratings.
- 2. **RAADOBARG** Finished fifth in the G2 Clipper Logistics Boomerang Mile over this trip at Leopardstown (Ireland). Place looks best.
- 3. MY RHAPSODY Japanese raider who was tailed off in the G2 Qatar Prix Foy over 2400m here. Opposed.
- 4. **RESHABAR** Moderate fifth in the G3 Barriere Prix Quincey at Deauville last outing. Vulnerable from a win perspective.
- 5. **EREVANN** Excellent 0.75L third in the G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-Le-Buffard Jacques Le Marois on just his fourth career start. Top claims.
- 6. **TRIPLE TIME** Returned from a lengthy break to win the G3 Superior Mile Stakes at Haydock (UK) last-time-out. No surprise were he good enough.
- 7. **FACTEUR CHEVAL** Suffered defeat for the first time when second to Checkandchallenge in the G3 Prix Daphnis over this trip at Deauville. Could be involved.
- 8. **MISTER SAINT PAUL** Bit more needed having finished behind a couple of these in the G3 Prix Daphnis at Deauville latest.
- 9. **CHECKANDCHALLENGE** Remains unexposed and looked back to something like his best when winning the 1600m G3 Prix Daphnis by 1L. Not ruled out.
- 10. **GLOUNTHAUNE** Good second to a progressive type in the G2 Clipper Logistics Boomerang Mile at Leopardstown (Ireland) after a break. Cannot be ignored for these connections.

**Summary**: This prize can stay in France courtesy of the unexposed EREVANN (5). The Jean-Claude Rouget trained colt proved he was up to top-class when an excellent 0.75L third in the G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois on just his fourth career start. Could prove hard to beat. The race could have panned out better for THE REVENANT (1) when he was beaten 6.25L into third in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp here. Genuine claims on ratings. TRIPLE TIME (6) made up for lost time when winning the G3 Superior Mile Stakes at Haydock (UK) last-time-out. Could be up to the task and hard to gauge just how good he is. CHECKANDCHALLENGE (9) completes the shortlist.

#### Race 9 - QATAR PRIX DE LA PLACE DE LA CONCORDE - 1600m HCP CL1. Purse EUR €70.000.

- 1. SKY POWER Won a Class Two conditions event over 1500m at Deauville last outing. Chance.
- 2. **HARPER** Followed up a Class One handicap success at Deauville with a good conditions second here. Player.
- 3. **DANTES** Tailed off at Deauville on reappearance. Is three from three here and should strip fitter for that recent outing. Market check needed.
- 4. **NOW WE KNOW** Not beaten far when sixth in a Class Two handicap over 1600m at Compiegne last start. Each-way chance.
- 5. SIMONS KING Held in a 2000m handicap here last-time-out. More required.
- 6. **MARRAKECH MOON** Dropped 0.5kg for being beaten 6.25L into seventh in a handicap at Deauville in August. Others preferred.
- 7. **VENTS CONTRAIRES** Good 1L third in a 1900m Class Two handicap on the AW at Deauville last start. Claims with the return to turf no issue.
- 8. **BILLABONG CAT** Denied a nose in a Class Two 1600m handicap at Compiegne last outing. Cannot be ignored if running to a similar level.
- 9. **MON AMI L'ECOSSAIS** Shaped fairly when beaten 3L into fifth over 1400m at this venue latest. Interesting under Guyon back up to 1600m.
- 10. **MEMORY DREAM** Won a Class Two conditions event at La Teste last outing but has been held off this mark in handicaps previously.
- 11. **ALBA POWER** Finished behind plenty of these in a handicap at Deauville last outing. More needed off the same mark.
- 12. **BE MY DAY** Made the running when third behind Harper at a big price two starts ago. Failed to replicate that since and must bounce back.
- 13. EVERILLO Tailed off over 1400m at Deauville six weeks ago. Others preferred.
- 14. **LADY PINK** Runner-up when racing off the front over this trip at Saint-Cloud last outing. Each-way contender.
- 15. **EL MANIFICO** Good second behind Harper in a Class Two handicap over this distance at Deauville two outings back. Not dismissed on that form.
- 16. **DETESNOUVELLES** Held over 1200m at Chantilly a fortnight ago and yet to run over 1600m. Others preferred.
- 17. FASTER Fair fifth in a 1600m handicap at Compiegne seventeen days ago. Place best.
